



Last night, Alejandra Ferrer and Daisee Aguilera put in appearances at *Nit de Turisme* (“Tourism Night”), a celebration of the best in Balearic tourism from 2017. The respective secretaries of tourism and environment were on hand as the Wednesday evening gala got under way in Palma’s Palau de Congressos, part of the celebrations for World Tourism Day.
